

Public Video Visitation Information

Inmate video visitation is available daily between the following hours: 08:00am to 10:50am : 1:00pm to 3:50pm : 7:30pm to 10:20pm. Visits will need to be started 20 minutes before ending time and are limited to 20 minutes in length. All video visitations may be monitored and recorded. Visits may be delayed, cancelled or denied at any time for facility needs.

Inmates currently housed with the Garfield County Detention Facility are responsible for notifying visitors of their available video visitation times, changes and cancellations. Visits for inmates serving disciplinary sanctions will not be allowed.

Video Visitation may also be conducted through the internet by visiting www.inmatecanteen.com. This method is fee-based and does not have a visit limit.

Not following any of the rules below may result in cancellation of your current visit and/or future visits being suspended or permanent revoked.

1. You may conduct only 1 onsite visit per day to a single inmate.
2. Accounts with fictitious names are not allowed.
3. Appropriate clothing must be worn during video visits.
4. Visitors will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. No profanity, disrespectful comments, disruptive behavior, threats of any kind, lewd or provocative behavior.
5. No loitering
6. No cell phones usage inside the visitation room.
7. No photographing or recording the visit.
8. No food or beverages are permitted in this room.
9. No smoking in or around this facility.
10. Under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
11. Any children present must not be disruptive.
12. No displaying any gang-related colors, symbols, materials and/or gestures.
13. No pets
14. No littering or leaving any possessions in this room.
15. Visitors can be subject to criminal charges if they are:
 - Found to be in violation of a court order.
 - Found to be in possession of drugs or other illegal items.
 - Public intoxication or under the influence of illegal drugs
 - Tampering or damage to any County property.
