**JOINT PRESS RELEASE

GLENWOOD SPRING, COLORADO – At approximately 10:54 a.m. the Garfield County Emergency Communication Center was notified of a bomb threat at the Garfield County Courthouse. An angry male called the Courthouse making statements that the building would blow-up sometime today. Sheriff's Deputies and Glenwood Springs Police Officers quickly evacuated three builds to include the Garfield County Courthouse, Garfield County Sheriff's Office and the Garfield County Administrative Building. The Courthouse was operating as usual along with two jury trials in progress, when approximately 200 people were evacuated from all three buildings.

At approximately 1:45 p.m. the bomb detection K-9 (Ben) and his handler, Officer Alan Foust with Foremost Response Security arrived out of Grand Junction and are in the process of clearing the buildings. The Grand Junction Bomb Squad is currently on standby incase a device is located. Information will be released as it becomes available.

All necessary precautions will be taken before reopening for business.

Agencies involved include; Garfield County Sheriff's Office, Glenwood Springs Police Department, Foremost Response Security Grand Junction Bomb Squad.
