ARIZONA ESCAPEE CAPTURED

GARFIELD COUNTY, Colo. – In the early morning hours of August 1, 2010. The Garfield County Emergency Communications Center was contacted by a Garfield County Sheriff's Deputy by radio requesting a License plate check for a suspicious vehicle.

The Deputy noticed a suspicious vehicle in the Rulison area, while trying get behind the vehicle on I-70 and run the license plate the driver's behavior became more suspicious then the vehicle exited I-70 at mile marker 87 (West Rifle). The Deputy relayed the license plate information to the dispatcher and once the dispatch center completed the vehicle clearance they confirmed with the Deputy that the suspicious vehicle was associated with an escape out of Arizona.

The Deputy then notified all local law enforcement and began putting together a plan to contact the suspicious vehicle with a high risk vehicle stop.

RIFLE, Colo. – Shortly after Midnight on Sunday, August 1, 2010 a Rifle Police Officer initiated a traffic stop on the suspicious vehicle spotted by Garfield

County Sheriff's Deputies in Rulison Colorado. Once the traffic stop was initiated the suspect vehicle failed to yield and exited I-70 Eastbound at mile marker 90, (the main Rifle exit). The suspect then fired one shot at the Rifle Police Officer hitting the patrol vehicle, the pursuit continued a short time and the Rifle Police Officer rammed the suspect vehicle disabling it and the suspect was taken into custody by the Rifle Police Officer. The suspect (Daniel Renwick) was transported to the Garfield County Jail and is being held with no bond.
