Each presentation will discuss the dangers associated with inhalants, marijuana, prescription drugs, methamphetamine and more with students gaining a better understanding of how dealers are using color, flavor and marketing ploys to entice users.**

**The public is invited to attend one of two sessions occurring Wednesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Coal Ridge High School and Monday, April 12<sup>th</sup>, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Grand Valley Middle School.
